

# 10 POPULAR SMALL PET FROGS THAT STAY SMALL



## GOLDEN MANTELLA



Scientific Name	Mantella aurantiaca
Size (adult)	1 inch (2.5 cm)
Weight (adult)	3-12 grams

The Madagascar golden frog is also named Golden Mantella. This one-inch frog is so vibrant and colorful that people often mistake these frogs as dart frogs.

These frogs are so tiny that a 5-gallon tank is sufficient

## GRAY TREE FROG



Scientific Name	Hyla versicolor
Size (adult)	1.25-2.25 inches
Weight (adult)	7.2 gm

One of the popular small arboreal pet frogs is the Gray tree frog. These frogs can reach up to 2.25 inches.

These small pet frogs are easy to take care of. The Gray tree frogs do not require high humidity in their tank consistently. Besides, the diet of Gray tree frogs is also pretty simple because of being insectivores.

## GLASS TREE FROG



Scientific Name	Hyalinobatrachium fleischmanni
Size (adult)	1.2-3 inches
Weight (adult)	5-14 gm

These frog have transparent translucent abdominal skin. Adult glass tree frogs weigh only 5-14 gm. Also, you need not worry about bringing a larger tank by thinking these frogs will become big being grown up.

You need to keep a pair of glass frogs in a 20-gallon arboreal tank.

## GREEN AND BLACK DART FROG



Scientific Name	Dendrobates auratus
Size (adult)	0.75-1.57 inches
Weight (adult)	Around 1 oz

If you want to bring colorful pet frogs that stay small, the first name to come into mind should be dart frogs. Among dart frogs, green and black dart frogs grow up to only 1.57 inches. This grape-sized frog weighs not more than 1 ounce.

## BURMESE CHUBBY FROG



Scientific Name	Kaloula pulchra
Size (adult)	2-3 inches
Weight (adult)	80-120 gm

Despite having chubbiness, Burmese Chubby frogs stay small. An adult Burmese chubby frog can grow up to only 2-3 inches. So, you can keep this cute, small frog on your favorite list if you are planning to keep tiny frogs as pets.

These frogs are too small that you can smoothly keep 2-3 chubby frogs in a 15-gallon enclosure.

## RED-EYED TREE FROG



Scientific Name	Agalychnis callidryas
Size (adult)	2-3 inches
Weight (adult)	0.013-0.03 lb

Vibrant, eye-catchy green body color and big red eyes are the unique features of this small frog.

The male red-eyed tree frogs are smaller and skinnier than the female frogs. If an adult male red-eyed tree frog grows up to 2 inches, an adult female red-eyed tree frog will be 3 inches big.

## AFRICAN DWARF FROG



Scientific Name	Hymenochirus
Size (adult)	Up to 3 inches
Weight (adult)	A few ounces

African dwarf frog is one of the most extraordinary pet frogs. These small frogs are special because of being fully aquatic amphibians.

Besides, these popular small frogs are pretty friendly and calm. So, you need not take much hassle in taking care of African dwarf frogs.

## CLOWN TREE FROG



Scientific Name	Dendropsophus ebraccatus
Size (adult)	Up to 3 inches
Weight (adult)	A few ounces

A clown tree frog is a small frog whose skin resembles the clown's attire. These popular small frogs make good pets for both experienced owners and beginners. Also, these clown tree frogs stay small all of their life that they reach up to only 1-2 inches.

You can easily keep these tiny pet frogs in a small enclosure

## BRAZILIAN GOLD FROG



Scientific Name	Brachycephalus didactylus
Size (adult)	0.34-0.40 inches
Weight (adult)	Less than one ounce

Brazilian gold frog is another perfect example of a popular small pet frog that stays small. This gold frog does not even grow up to 1 cm. You might even compare these frogs with small houseflies for their size.

Their small sizes allow them to fit in a small enclosure of the size of a shoebox.

## STRAWBERRY DART FROG



Scientific Name	Oophaga pumilio
Size (adult)	0.59-2.4 inches
Weight (adult)	1 ounce

Strawberry dart frogs have already caught the attention of frog lovers with their striking strawberry red-colored skin and deep blue legs. These high demanded frogs also stay small reaching up to only 2.4 inches in their maturity.

You should keep the room temperature around 70-80 degrees in the daytime.
